Auction

Welcome to the BDS online & postal fundraising auction which will be hosted on eBay charity pages. To view, go to the BDS website www.bds.org.uk and click on the link to eBay, which will be active when the auction starts early evening on 19th May, or go to www.eBay.co.uk and search for the British Deer Society. To give you a better opportunity and more time to win a lot, we have staggered starting times in three batches **starting on 19th, 20th & 21st May**. Each batch will run for 10 days with the respective closing dates of **29th, 30th & 31st May 2017**. The exact closing time for individual lots will appear alongside each lot description on eBay. The highest bidder for each lot at the end of the auction will win that lot.

Bids on eBay

Bidding can be fast and furious in the closing stages so you may want to keep an eye on your bids during the course of the final evening. Bid closing times for each lot are shown on eBay. Bidding on eBay is simple and works similarly to leaving "commission bids" at a live auction. You place a maximum bid for the lot. As the listing proceeds, eBay compares your bid to those of other bidders. When you're outbid, eBay automatically bids on your behalf up to the maximum bid you have entered. Your bid is increased by increments only as much as necessary to maintain your high bid position. For instance, if you bid £100 for a lot and the next highest bidder bids £50, you will only have to pay £55 to become the highest bidder or win the lot, even though you placed a bid for £100. Once you have made your bid, you therefore don't need to closely monitor the site or bid repeatedly on an auction on eBay. Having placed your maximum bid if you are later outbid, eBay will notify you by email, so you can decide whether to increase your bid.

You will however not be informed if you have been outbid. Successful Bidders

If you win the auction for a lot, you can pay instantly by using PayPal or by contacting the BDS with cheque or credit card details. BDS will then write to you to put you in contact with the donor of the lot to arrange the details etc. eBay does not charge winning bidders any fees – you will pay only the exact amount of your winning bid. The seller (the BDS in this case) pays a small commission to eBay for hosting the auction.

You can view current bids or browse other auctions without registering with eBay. However if you would like to bid directly on eBay you will need to register. Go to www.ebay.co.uk and click on 'eBay explained'. For the new user registration page go to www.ebay.co.uk and click on 'Register'. Once you are registered and have a User ID, you can place bids on any lots being auctioned on eBay.
