Gift Aid Explained

Gift Aid is a government scheme that allows charities to claim back the basic rate of tax on donations received from UK taxpayers. Currently, for every £1 you donate, the British Deer Society can claim an extra 25p at no extra cost to you. In order to qualify for Gift Aid, you must pay an amount of income or capital gains tax at least equal to that claimed by BDS on your donation.

If you pay income tax at the higher rate, you must include all your Gift Aid donations on your Self-Assessment tax return if you want to receive the additional tax relief due to you. Please notify The British Deer Society if you want to cancel this declaration, change your name or home address or you no longer pay sufficient tax on your income and/or capital gains.

If an error is made in the payment of your Direct Debit, by The British Deer Society or your bank or building society, you are entitled to a full and immediate refund of the amount paid from your bank or building society. If you receive a refund you are not entitled to, you must pay back when The British Deer Society ask you to.

You can cancel a Direct Debit at any time by simply contacting your bank or building society. Written confirmation may be required. Please also notify us.
