



Deer Vehicle Collision Humane Animal Despatch Course

Developed primarily for the police and their nominated DVC call out staff, this course serves a requirement to demonstrate, should it become necessary, that operatives have undergone formal training in roadside despatch of injured deer. Approved and certificated by Lantra Awards, the course is now being made available to all members and non members of the Society.

Through a number of presentations, the classroom based course advises on operating procedures involving all personnel from police control room staff to the person involved in carrying out any roadside despatch. A major element of the course examines the legal implications of carrying out roadside despatch. This should be done quickly to relieve suffering whilst at the same time avoid placing an operative in a position whereby an infringement of legislation might occur.

The course focuses on risk assessment and safe operation together with looking at other relevant issues. The course is designed to be interactive and attendees are encouraged to discuss and debate areas of concern. The cost of the course is £80.00 and lasts approximately 6 hours and includes Lantra registration and a certificate of attendance.
